Because Little People Sunday Worship is a parent co-op program where one adult per participating family is scheduled to be the Catechist or assistant several times a semester, this program is free of charge. Families are not obliged to participate every week.

Show and Tell is one of our favorite features. Not only does it give our catechists and helpers an opportunity to get to know the children better but it also allows children to bring a little piece of home with them. This can often bring comfort to them in this new situation while encouraging them to speak up and share with their new found friends.
