## The Coaches Code of Conduct

In an effort to make youth sports a more desirable and rewarding experience for all participants, St. Anthony Athletics believes that all coaches should adhere to certain points of emphasis relating to sportsmanship. This commitment is important in our quest to maintain a positive and educational atmosphere in all competitive situations.

- I will teach my players to play **fairly** and to respect the rules, officials, opponents, and the program.
- I will ensure that all players get instruction, support and **play time** in an equitable manner.
- I will not ridicule or yell at my players for making mistakes or for performing badly.
- I will remember that players play to have fun and must be encouraged to have **confidence** in themselves.
- I will make sure that equipment and facilities are **safe** and match the player's ages and abilities.
- I will remember that participants need a coach they can **respect**. I will be generous with **praise** and set a good example.
- I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.
- I will work in cooperation with Officials, Youth League Staff and facility staff for the benefit of the player and the game.
- I will be reasonable with my expectations for games and practices, remembering that players have other interests and obligations.
- I will show by example by leading my players in Spiritual and Service activities in our parish. I know that failure to do so could jeopardize my chances of coaching.
- I will respect my usage time in the gym and the entire grounds that we use for practice and games.
- I will supervise and encourage the children to respect the grounds and facilities while they are in use during practice and games.
