


St. Anthony and St. Joseph Parishes Footsteps of Christianity in England

Day 2 – 07Oct – Arrive London Heathrow 7:45am – Meet our motorcoach and guide in the arrivals area. Group will depart Heathrow and travel to Stonehedge. Visit Stonehenge Britian's most famous monument built between 3100 and 1100 BC. Continue to Salisburuy for walking tour and visit to magnificent Cathedral. Arrive Winchester in time for check-in at the Hotel. Group will dine at the hotel this evening. (B,D)

**Day 3 - O8Oct** - After a full English Breakfast at the Voco Hotel, group will check-out and then visit the Winchester Cathedral. All aboard the private motorcoach for journey to our next stop – Cambridge. Afternoon walking tour of Cambridge viewing the ancient University buildings. Check-in to the Hyatt Centric Hotel your accommodation for the next two nights. Group dinner this evening in Cambridge. (B,D)

**Day 4** – **O9Oct** - After enjoying a full English Breakfast at the Hotel Hyatt Centric, Our private guide will start tour on motorcoach to The Augustinian Priory in Walsingham, one of the main centers for Christian Pilgrimage in England. Our group will visit the remains of the Augustinian Priory which dates from 1153. Then the group will take a scenic tour along the North Norfolk Coast before returning to our accommodation in Cambridge. This evening is time to enjoy the town of Cambridge on your own for dinner and evening stroll. (B)

Day 5 – 10Oct – Full English Breakfast this morning at the Hotel Hyatt Centric before heading north, stopping enroute to Lincoln, renowned for its majestic triple-towered cathedral, the third largest church in England. Afternoon arrival at the Doubletree by Hilton Hotel in York, accommodations for the next two evenings. There will be time this evening to enjoy the town of York on your own. Have fun finding the most famous foods of York at local establishments...Yorkshire pudding, Yorkshire Tea or perhaps a Fat Rascal (cake). (B)

**Day 6 – 11Oct** – Enjoy a full English Breakfast at the hotel this morning. Join the guide this morning for a walking tour of the historic city. See the ancient streets and city walls and visit York Minster, England's largest Gothic church noted for its majestic towers and priceless stained-glass windows. Then enjoy an afternoon excursion to Fountains Abbey near Ripon. Founded in 1133 by thirteen dissident Benedictine monks, the Abbey soon became the wealthiest Cistercian foundation in England. Return to York for overnight and enjoy dinner at your leisure. (B,D)

**Day 7 – 12Oct** – After another delicious full English breakfast this morning, group will head North to Edinburgh, stop for a visit to Holdy Island and the atmospheric ruins of Lindisfarne Priory. Set off the northeast coast just south from Berwick-upon-Tweed, this is one of the holiest Anglo-Saxon sites in England renowned as the original burial place of St. Cuthbert. Conclude the day in Edinburgh where accommodation is reserved for two nights at the Leonardo Hotel Haymarket. (B)

**Day 8 – 13Oct** – Traditional Scottish breakfast will be served this morning at the Hotel Leonardo. Our private guide will lead us this morning on a sightseeing tour including a drive along *The Royal Mile* passing by St. Giles Cathedral and visit to the beautiful Palace of Holyroodhouse (the Queen's only official residence in Scotland) and Edinburgh Castle. Afternoon at leisure. Dine this evening in the underground vaults at Marlin's Mynd which dates to the 16<sup>th</sup> century. (B)

**Day 9 – 14Oct** – Today after breakfast we will board the train from Edinburgh to London King's Cross, then transfer by coach to our hotel in London and enjoy an orientation tour of the city enroute. Check-in to our hotel St. Giles, in London, where accommodation is reserved for the next three nights.(B)

**Day 10 – 15Oct** – London tour will begin when group finishes breakfast at our hotel. Join our coach and special blue-badge guide, Steve Fallon on a full day tour in London visiting Westminster Cathedral, South-walk Cathedral and the South Bank. (B)

**Day 11 – 16Oct** - After breakfast, our guide will lead us to Canterbury and Aylesford, England's most famed Cathedral city. Explore the cobbled streets walked by Chaucer's pilgrims, visit the very roots of Christianity at the ruined St. Augustine's Abbey and enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent Cathedral, the Mother Church of the Anglican Communion and the country's first Cathedral, founded by St. Augustine in 597AD. Enjoy lunch today at Lloyd's Restaurant, a listed building situated on the boundary of Canterbury's historic city walls. On return to London, stop to visit Aylesford Priory, the ancient religious house of the Order of Carmelites dating back to 13<sup>th</sup> Century. (B,L)

**Day12 – 17Oct** – After enjoying our last breakfast with the group, we will wish farewell to Great Britian with a big 'cheerio' as group heads to the airport to board American Airlines departing London at1:00pm. Arrival in Philadelphia will be 3:45pm. (B)
