Day 1 – Tues. Nov. 10, Arrival Mexico City from USA (D) Depart Philadelphia at 9:05am Aero Mexico non-stop flight arriving Mexico City 1:35pm Welcome to Mexico! Your Tour Director will greet you upon arrival for transfer to your hotel. This evening, join your group for a Welcome Dinner.

Day 2 – Wed. Nov. 11, Mexico City (B, D) A full day of touring awaits as you travel to Puebla, one of Mexico's most beautiful colonial cities. On a walking tour, visit the Cathedral de Puebla and Santo Domingo Church. The Cathedral de Puebla is one of the most important and beautiful cathedrals in the Americas. It dominates Puebla's Zocalo with its massive towers, rich interior, and centuries of history. The cathedral is considered one of the most significant buildings in Puebla's UNESCO-listed historic center (designated 1987). At Capilla del Rosario, marvel at the Mexican Baroque architecture and stunning tile work. Enjoy free time to explore on your own before returning to Mexico City for dinner

Day 3 – Thurs. Weds. Nov. 12, Mexico City (B) After breakfast, spend the morning at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe to see the Old Basilica, Tepayac Hill and the Chapel of Apparitions. Our Lady of Guadalupe is one of the most visited Catholic shrines in the world. According to Catholic tradition, it is the site where Saint Juan Diego met the Virgin of Guadalupe in December 1531 and received the iconic image of the Lady of Guadalupe. Spanish colonists erected a Catholic chapel at the site, Our Lady of Guadalupe "the place of many miracles". Attend Holy Mass. This afternoon, take a guided walking tour of Mexico City to see the Metropolitan Cathedral, Zocalo main square, Templo Mayor and Palaco de Bellas Artes. The Metropolitan Cathedral is officially known as the Cathedral of the Assumption of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven, is the cathedral church of the Catholic Archdiocese of Mexico. Zocalo, or Plaza de la Constitucion, is one of Mexico City's most popular spots that dates back to the Aztec era. It's a large and historic public plaza that never sleeps, always buzzing with traditional Aztec dancers and performers and cultural events. The square is surrounded by beautiful architecture and landmarks, such as Palacio Bellas Artes and the Templo Mayor, making it a great starting point to explore the city. Be sure to join a city walking tour to learn more about the history and culture of Zocalo. Return to your hotel for an evening of leisure.

Day 4 – Fri. Nov. 13, Tlaxcala (B, D) Travel south of the city to enjoy a Xochimilco canals boat ride including snacks. Visit San Juan Bautista Church in Coyoacan. The Xochimilco canals are a UNESCO World Heritage site famous for their colorful trajinera boats and ancient floating gardens called chinampas. The canals are often compared to a "Venice of Mexico City". San Juan Bautista Church in Coyoacán is one of Mexico City's oldest and most historically significant colonial churches, a landmark that anchors the heart of Villa Coyoacán. San Juan Bautista is a 16th-century Catholic church and former convent, founded between 1522 and 1552 on land granted to Franciscan friars shortly after the Spanish conquest. It stands on the south side of Plaza Hidalgo, one of Coyoacán's central squares. Enjoy free time in the artisan markets and historic plaza. Return to Mexico City to celebrate with a farewell dinner and Mariachi show.

Day 5 – Sat. Nov. 14, Mexico City (B) After breakfast, transfer to Mexico City airport for non-stop Aero Mexico flight departing 1:45pm arriving Philadelphia 7:34pm.
